

DO'S...

- Have your system maintained. It prolongs the system's life and stops small problems becoming big problems.
- Let us know straight away if you split an irrigation line or similar and always call if the red light goes on.
- Clean out the tank approximately every 3 years, if you look after the system this can be greatly extended. Your maintenance technician will let you know when it is due.
- Spread the load. Showering, doing the laundry and using the dishwasher at the same time will cause overloading.
- Use Biodegradable soaps. This enables quick breakdown of waste
- Scrape excess fat and food scraps off the plates & pots
- When you sell the property, please let Reflections know.
- Use Septizyme if the system has an odour or if you have been using antibiotics or other harsh drugs/chemicals. If you have a smelly drain in the house, Septizyme will also clear this.
- Carbon filters can be fitted if the odour is on going.
- Mow around the system, sand filter, trenches etc.
- Maintain any storm water diversion or cut-off drains

Don'ts...

- Excessive bleaches or disinfectants damage your system, use in moderation.
- Garbage grinders overload your system, scraps are better off in the compost bin or worm farm.
- Do not flush ANY sanitary products or condoms down the toilet. The plastic wraps are lethal to your system.
- Covering any vents, sand beds or access lids will prevent maintenance & cleaning from being performed and could build up excessive levels of dangerous gas.
- You must prevent stock and vehicles from accessing the trenches, irrigation lines and beds.
- Please consult Reflections before putting any topsoil on the beds as they must breathe to operate. Never place Clay on the beds.
- Avoid doing multiple loads of laundry in one day, spread it through the week or it may overload your system.
- Don't plant willows, poplars or plants with evasive roots near your filter bed, trenches or irrigation lines. Talk to Reflections for planting lists
